

GEARS Monday Night Net K6CCC Repeater 445.380 MHz - 100 Hz

Read slowly and speak clearly.

6:55 p.m. (1855 hrs.):

QST, QST, QST, This is (*your call sign*), net control station of the Glendale Emergency Auxiliary Radio Service. A scheduled net will be conducted on this frequency in five minutes. The cooperation of all radio amateurs on this frequency during the net to begin at 1900 hours will be greatly appreciated. This is (*your call sign*), clear.

7:00 p.m. (1900 hrs.):

QST, QST, QST. This is (*your call sign in proper phonetics*), net control station of the Glendale Emergency Auxiliary Radio Service. The net control operator is (*your name*). A net will be conducted on this frequency for the next several minutes. We request a clear frequency and would appreciate the cooperation of all radio amateurs during this net.

(Wait for a repeater break)

This is a directed, open net. All licensed amateur radio operators are invited to participate. First, we will stand by for any emergency traffic. If there is any emergency traffic, please call now.

(Pause and wait for any emergency traffic)

Identify as (your call sign) at least once every 10 minutes

MESSAGES (Read this section if there are any GEARS messages.)

I will now read the GEARS messages. (*Read the GEARS messages.*) Does anyone need a fill? (*Pause.*)

CHECK-INS

(*Your call sign*), will now call for check-ins. Please state your call sign in proper phonetics, name, current location, and total hours since your last check-in. Anyone wishing to check in to the GEARS net, please call now.

(Record check-in.)

Additional check-ins?

(Repeat until there are no responses. Then, invite guest check-ins.)

Are there any guests who wish to check in to the GEARS net?

QUESTIONS OR MESSAGES FOR THE NET

MEETINGS

GEARS meets on the second Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m. in the Emergency Operations Center. The EOC is in the basement of City Hall, located at 613 East Broadway, between Glendale Avenue and Isabel Street. The entrance stairway is in the rear by the Coke machine.

(Respond to the questions or messages.)

CLOSING THE NET

This is (*your call sign in proper phonetics*), net control station of the Glendale Emergency Auxiliary Radio Service. This net is held on this frequency every Monday night at 1900 hours local time. We thank all radio amateurs for their cooperation and participation during this net. This is (*your call sign*), clear.

INSTRUCTIONS

Please read the entire script and all messages before running the net. Do not try to do a cold on-the-air reading.

- ❑ Arrive with plenty of time to get the key from the Watch Sergeant at the police station.**
- ❑ The pre-net message must be transmitted by 1855 hours.**
- ❑ Start the net promptly at 1900 hours.**
- ❑ Fill in the GEARS log sheets.**
- ❑ Return the key to the Watch Sergeant at the police station.**
